Jane Addams Hull House to close

The need for its services is as strong as ever, but after years of rising costs and dwindling income from fundraising the Jane Addams Hull House Association will close and <u>file</u> for bankruptcy, the agency said today.

"For the last several years the agency has had trouble in the <u>fundraising</u> side of things," said Stephen Saunders, chair of the association's board of trustees. "After many years of struggling, we have to close our doors. It was a very difficult decision."

Bring together content about the city of Chicago from multiple institutions into a single discovery system


- Initial focus: Descriptive metadata and finding aids about archival collections
